Renaissance College Hong Kong (RCHK) Class of 2025 Achieves Outstanding IB Results

Hong Kong, 8 July 2025: Renaissance College is thrilled to announce the exceptional International Baccalaureate (IB) Programme results for the Class of 2025, with the vast majority of graduates successfully securing their first-choice university placements. These impressive achievements underscore the dedication of our students and the unwavering support of our faculty.

Exceeding Expectations Amidst Growth

The Class of 2025 has once again demonstrated RCHK's commitment to academic excellence. We are proud to report a **remarkable 94% pass rate for the full IB Diploma**, significantly surpassing global averages. The cohort achieved an impressive **average total point score of 36 points**. This success is particularly noteworthy given the increase in the total number of students in this graduating class, highlighting the college's continued ability to maintain high standards even with a growing student body and increased range of subjects on offer.

Celebrating Bilingual Proficiency and Top Scorers

A distinctive highlight of this year's results is the continued strength in bilingualism within our student community. Nearly **14% of our students were eligible to receive the prestigious bilingual diploma**, a testament to their dedication to mastering multiple languages. Of those eligible, an outstanding **100% successfully earned the bilingual diploma** by taking two native or near-native language courses.

Furthermore, **29% of our students achieved 40 or more total points**, a score that positions them as highly competitive applicants for top-tier universities worldwide, including Ivy League institutions and Oxbridge. We are especially proud to announce that 3 of our students achieved the perfect score of 45 points.

The pass rate for the Career-related Programme was **100%** for this cohort, reflecting a high level of control over outcomes as our career-related specialisms continue to grow in breadth.

It is pertinent to note that the above scores achieved in the Reflective Project are indicative of the candidates' strong independent research skills and this component is given equal weighting to the DP Extended Essay by UCAS. The students' grade point average of SCAD and SUMAS is also extremely impressive, given that these courses equate to first year university courses in their level of challenge and credit. 3 of our students achieved a grade point average of 4, meaning they gained 5 As for all of the foundation courses they took at SCAD. The BTEC and Hospitality (HTI/ICI) average functions to support students towards a career in the performing arts and hospitality respectively and a distinction is the highest possible award.

As an outcome of excellence, a total of 40 students have been awarded the ESF Chairman's Awards this year. The English Schools Foundation Chairman's Awards recognizes the outstanding achievements of ESF graduates.
