

Results for the IB Diploma (IBDP) / Courses Programmes and Career-related Programme

Renaissance College is thrilled to announce the exceptional International Baccalaureate (IB) Programme results for the Class of 2026. The students were awarded an impressive set of IB results and the vast majority of students have secured their first choice of university. With a 98% pass rate, and an average total point score of 36.3 points, the college continues to surpass global averages. Within these figures, it is worth drawing attention to the continued high rate of students who qualified for the bilingual diploma (achieved by taking two native / near native language courses). In this cohort, nearly 14% of the students were eligible to receive the bilingual diploma, and 100% of them earned it.

An additional level of success can be seen by the fact that 29% of our students achieved 40 or more total points - a figure that would place them as competitive Ivy League or Oxbridge applicants. Moreover, three of our students achieved a total of 45 points.

A further breakdown of the results for the May 2026 IB DP cohort is as follows:

The pass rate for the Career Related Programme was 100% for this cohort, reflecting a high level of control over outcomes as the cohort continues to grow year on year. The following summary provides further details of the Career Related student achievements:

It is pertinent to note that the above scores achieved in the Reflective Project are indicative of the candidates' strong independent research skills, and this component is given equal weighting to the DP Extended Essay by UCAS. The students' SCAD and Embry-Riddle grade point average is also extremely impressive, given that these courses equate to first year university courses in their level of challenge and credit.

As an outcome of excellence, a total of 26 students have been awarded the ESF Chairman's Awards.

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
